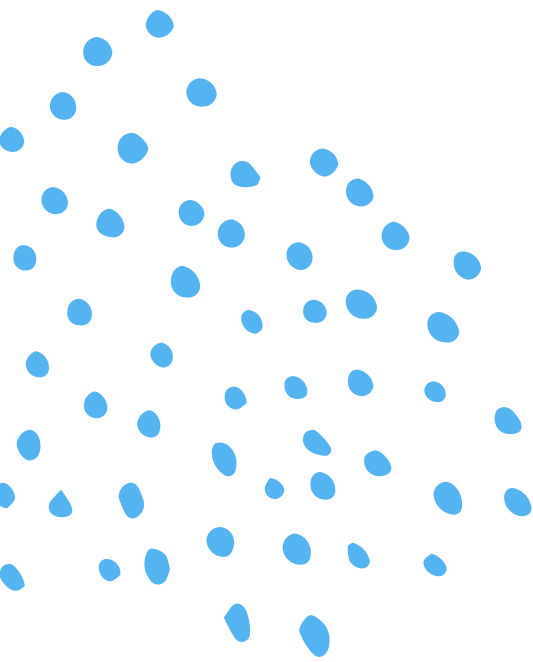




Child Carrel / Computer Station

Board Book Bins

Mobile book bins for board books are placed in **areas where families gather**. Caregivers can easily find books to read to younger siblings.
